RUTH B. BILLADO BURLINGTON — Ruth B. Billado passed away peacefully March 13, 2005, surrounded by her family in Haven Health Center in St. Albans. She was born in Galion, Ohio, April 6, 1908. She was the daughter of the late Frank R. and Cora (Shaw) Bourquin. She moved to Rutland as a young girl and attended schools there. She later went on to college at Syracuse University and graduated from Fredonia State University with a degree in art education. She taught school in the Rutland school system until her marriage to Francis W. Billado of Rutland, on Nov. 26, 1938. Together the couple had three children. In 1956, the family moved to Burlington. After the death of General Billado, Ruth began a new career in 1968 at Champlain College in Burlington, where she briefly taught art and then became responsible for the interior design at the college until her retirement in 1985. She was extremely proud of her association with the college and her many accomplishments. She cherished her many friends and colleagues she met there. She was a member of the Burlington Klifa Club and the Vermont National Guard Wives Club. Ruth took great pleasure in volunteering as a reader for the late Bishop Robert Joyce during the latter years of his life. She loved her life, family, and friends. She will be greatly missed by all. She is survived by her son, F.W. Billado Jr. and his wife Sheara of Shelburne; her daughters, Barrie Cohen and her husband William of Virginia Beach, Va., and Virginia Farrell and partner C. Barry Sageman, also of Shelburne; her eight grandchildren, F.W. Billado III, Jeffery Billado and his wife Julie, Gregory Cohen and his wife Annie, Lindsey C. Michlik and her husband Jerry, Thomas Kulhowvick and his wife Marcela, Tracy Farrell, and Kelsey and Christopher Sageman; her four great-grandchildren, Danielle Cohen, Riley and Cole Michlik, and Katalina Kulhowvick; and several nieces and nephews. Her sister, Helen Pheil; and infant brother Donald Bourquin predeceased her.
